PETITION TO INTERVENE OF NEXTERA ENERGY RESOURCES, LLC

Pursuant to the notice published in the Federal Register on November 8, 2012 regarding the Bonneville Power Administration's ("BPA") Fiscal Year (FY) 2014-2015 Proposed Power and Transmission Rate Adjustments Public Hearing and Opportunities for Public Review and Comment, 77 Fed. Reg. 66966-66973, and Section 1010.4 of the Procedures Governing Bonneville Power Administration Rate Hearings, 51 Fed. Reg. 7611 (1986), NextEra Energy Resources, LLC ("NextEra Resources") hereby files this Petition to Intervene as a party in the above-captioned proceeding.

I. BACKGROUND

NextEra Energy Resources, LLC ("NextEra Resources") is the merchant generating subsidiary of NextEra Energy, Inc. NextEra Resources' subsidiaries own and operate wind energy generating facilities interconnected with the system of BPA, and NextEra Resources subsidiaries are also transmission customers of BPA. As such, many of these NextEra Resources' generating facilities are transmission customers or eligible customers in the interconnection queue of BPA Transmission Services that will be directly affected by the rates, terms and conditions that BPA will consider in this proceeding. Accordingly, NextEra Resources has a substantial interest in the outcome of this proceeding, and there is no other party that can adequately represent NextEra Resources' interests in this proceeding.
