PETITION TO INTERVENE

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Pursuant to Rule 1010.4(b) of the Bonneville Power Administration (“BPA”) Rules of Procedure Governing Rate Hearings and the Federal Register Notice dated November 8, 2012 (77 Fed. Reg. 66966), The City of Seattle hereby petitions to intervene as a party in the above-captioned proceeding to establish BPA’s wholesale power rates and transmission rates for the 2014 and 2015 fiscal years. The City of Seattle, City Light Department is a publicly owned electric utility that generates and sells electricity to nearly 400,000 customers in its service area. The City of Seattle is a major customer of BPA with respect to both wholesale power and transmission services.
