**This email is in response to BPA's request for comments on the Southern Intertie Hourly Non- Firm Rate.**

At the August 27<sup>th</sup> BPA Workshop Powerex made a proposal to change the rate formula that calculates the hourly non-firm rate on the Southern Intertie (SI). This proposal was made as a result of an observed discrepancy in value extracted between the NW and Cal ISO in transactions on the SI.

While EWEB doesn't dispute there is an issue that warrants attention, we encourage BPA to commence a forum to discuss both rate and non-rate solutions together and not rush to a pure rate solution.
