Pursuant to Section 1010.4 of the Bonneville Power Administration (“BPA”) Rules of Procedure Governing Rate Hearings, and BPA’s Federal Register Notice for this proceeding, the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (“ICNU”) respectfully petitions the Bonneville Power Administration (“BPA”) for an Order granting ICNU full party status in this proceeding.

3. On December 4, 2014, BPA published its Federal Register notice regarding the 2016 Power and Transmission Rate Case. As part of this public process, BPA will be conducting a formal hearing. ICNU intends to participate as a party in the formal proceeding.

4. ICNU is an incorporated, non-profit association of large industrial electric customers in the Pacific Northwest, with offices in Portland, Oregon. A list of ICNU members is included as Attachment A. Many members of ICNU are end-use customers of BPA, as indicated on Attachment A.

5. ICNU's members have a substantial interest in the outcome of this proceeding. Since 1981, ICNU has been a party to all of BPA's rate cases. Many of ICNU's members obtain electric service from public agencies that receive all or a majority of their power and transmission from BPA, and some members take service through contracts that pass BPA's rate changes directly to the ICNU member. In addition, many ICNU members have, or in the future may have, retail direct access. Direct access customers may purchase transmission service directly from BPA. Thus, most ICNU members are directly affected by the rates, terms and conditions that BPA will consider in this proceeding. ICNU's intervention in this proceeding will assist BPA in resolving the issues in this proceeding and will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or unreasonably delay this proceeding.

6. The substantial interests of ICNU's members are not represented by any other parties in this proceeding. ICNU's participation will assist BPA in its consideration of the issues that may arise in this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, ICNU respectfully requests that the Hearing Officer grant its petition to intervene with full party status in this proceeding.
