**PETITION TO INTERVENE OF  
PORTLAND GENERAL ELECTRIC  
COMPANY**

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Pursuant to the notice posted in the Federal Register on November 8, 2012, regarding Bonneville Power Administration's ("BPA") Proposed Oversupply Rates, 77 Fed. Reg. 66963 (2012), and section 1010.4 of the Rules Procedure Governing Bonneville Power Administration Rate Hearings. See 51 Fed. Reg. 7611-01 (1986), Portland General Electric Company ("PGE") hereby files this petition to intervene as a party in these proceedings. PGE requests that it be granted party status in BPA Docket No. OS-14, including any subdockets to that proceeding.

**I. PETITION TO INTERVENE**

PGE is a corporation created and organized under the laws of the State of Oregon with its principal office in Portland, Oregon. PGE is an investor-owned utility engaged in, among other things, the business of generating, transmitting, and distributing electric power to retail customers in Oregon. PGE purchases long and short-term firm and non-firm transmission service from BPA. As a purchaser of control area service, PGE may be subject to the proposed control area service charge. PGE's cost of providing electric service to its retail customers may be directly and materially affected by the outcome of this proceeding.

Accordingly, PGE has an interest in these proceedings and is eligible to be a party in this proceeding. *See* 77 Fed. Reg. 66963 (2012). PGE's interests cannot be adequately represented by any other party, and, therefore, respectfully requests that it be allowed to intervene as a party in the above-captioned proceedings.

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
