PETITION TO INTERVENE

Pursuant to the Federal Register Notice in this matter, 77 FR 66963 (November 8, 2012), and Rule 1010.4 of Bonneville Power Administration's (BPA's) Procedures Governing Bonneville Power Administration; Rate Hearings, 51 FR 7611 (March 5, 1986), Pacific Northwest Generating Cooperative (PNGC) respectfully submits this Petition to Intervene in this docket and to participate as a Party.

In support of this petition, PNGC states the following:

2. PNGC has the following interest in the proceeding. PNGC is a cooperative corporation organized under the laws of the State of Oregon and is a Joint Operating Entity pursuant to the Northwest Power Act, 16 USC § 839(c)(b)(7). It purchased power from the BPA Power Services under a Contract High Water Mark Contract to meet the needs of the utilities that will be its members during 2012. In addition, PNGC will purchase power from BPA Power

Services under a Contract High Water mark Contract to meet the needs of its members through September 30, 2015. PNGC's members are:

PNGC purchased transmission services from BPA Transmission Services on its own behalf and as the designated agent of the utilities that will be its members during 2012 and will do so through September 30, 2015. Therefore, as a transmission customer of BPA, PNGC claims a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding.
