PETITION TO INTERVENE

Pursuant to Rule 1010.4(b) of the Bonneville Power Administration (“BPA”) Rules of Procedure Governing Rate Hearings and the Federal Register Notice dated November 8, 2012 (77 Fed. Reg. 66963), The City of Seattle hereby petitions to intervene as a party in the above-captioned proceeding to establish a rate to recover costs incurred under BPA’s Oversupply Management Protocol. The City of Seattle presents the following facts in support of this petition.

The City of Seattle, City Light Department is a publicly owned electric utility that generates and sells electricity to nearly 400,000 customers in its service area. The City of Seattle is a major customer of BPA with respect to both wholesale power and transmission services, and will pay a portion of any costs related to BPA’s Oversupply Management Protocol that are included in its rates for wholesale power or transmission services. The City of Seattle therefore has a direct and substantial interest in participating in this proceeding, which cannot be adequately represented by any other entity that may become a party.
