**PETITION TO INTERVENE OF
PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1 OF SNOHOMISH COUNTY**

Public Utility District No. 1 of Snohomish County, Washington (“Snohomish”), respectfully petitions for leave to intervene in the above-captioned proceeding pursuant to section 1010.4 of the Bonneville Power Administration’s (“BPA”) Rules of Procedure Governing Rate Hearings and the Federal Register Notice published November 8, 2012 (77 Fed. Reg. 66963). In support of this Petition, Snohomish states:

Snohomish is a consumer-owned utility and a municipal corporation of the State of Washington formed by a majority vote of the people for the purpose of providing electric and/or water utility service. Snohomish purchases approximately 84% of its electric energy from BPA, and is BPA’s largest public agency customer. As a purchaser of wholesale electric power from BPA, Snohomish’s rates are subject to revision in the above-captioned proceeding. Therefore, Snohomish is entitled to intervene in this proceeding pursuant to section 1010.4 of BPA’s Rules of Procedure Governing Rate Hearings.
