**PETITION TO INTERVENE OF PUBLIC POWER COUNCIL**

Pursuant to the notice provided by the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) on its website, entitled “Petition to Intervene in the FY 2010-2011 ASC Review Process,” the Public Power Council (PPC) petitions the Administrator to allow it to intervene in BPA’s FY 2010-2011 ASC Review Process, through which BPA seeks to review utilities’ Appendix 1 filings and issue Final Average System Cost (ASC) Reports. PPC hereby requests intervention in each of the above-noted dockets in which BPA will be considering an investor-owned utility’s ASC filings for FY 2010-11.

PPC is a non-profit trade association that represents the common interests of the over 100 consumer-owned electric utilities in the Northwest that are preference

customers of BPA. PPC represents the interests of its members on issues of power supply and transmission.

PPC has a relevant interest in BPA's FY 2010-11 ASC Review Process because PPC's members purchase power from BPA at rates that may be affected by the outcome of this process, which will affect the amount and distribution of Residential Exchange Program benefits for FY 2010-11. PPC has an interest in the total costs of the Residential Exchange Program, because the costs of the program are collected through BPA's rates for preference customers. In addition, PPC has an interest in ensuring that benefits under that program are allocated appropriately based on utilities' system costs.


