

**COLUMBIA RIVER TREATY ENTITY AGREEMENT
ON THE
2012 NON-TREATY STORAGE AGREEMENT**

The Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) and the British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority (B.C. Hydro) have signed an agreement relating to the use of Columbia River non-Treaty storage for the period 1 April 2012 through 15 September 2024 (BPA contract number 12PG-10002). The United States and Canadian Entities have reviewed this Agreement and are satisfied that there are mutual benefits to be derived from it and that these benefits can be achieved without adversely affecting: (1) the operation of Treaty storage in Canadian projects in accordance with the Columbia River Treaty; or (2) the performance of Treaty obligations pursuant to the agreement entitled "Aspects of Delivery of the Canadian Entitlement."


