


**COLUMBIA RIVER TREATY ENTITY AGREEMENT
RELATING TO EXTENSION OF THE EXPIRATION DATE
OF THE NON-TREATY STORAGE AGREEMENT**

The Bonneville Power Administration and the British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority on 5 July 1990 signed the Non-Treaty Storage Agreement with an expiration date of 30 June 2003. On 9 July 1990, the U.S. and Canadian Entities signed an Entity Agreement relating to the use of Columbia River non-Treaty Storage and specifying that the 5 July 1990 Agreement was in effect.

The Bonneville Power Administration and the British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority have recently extended the Non-Treaty Storage Agreement for a period of one year to 30 June 2004. The U.S. and Canadian Entities have reviewed this extension and concur that the operations contemplated by the extension will not adversely affect the operation of Treaty storage in accordance with the Columbia River Treaty or the performance of obligations under the Columbia River Treaty or related agreements.
