


## COLUMBIA RIVER TREATY

### ENTITY AGREEMENT


The Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) and the British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority (B.C. Hydro) have signed an agreement relating to the use of Columbia River non-Treaty storage for the period 25 May 2006 through 30 September 2006 (BPA Contract number 06PB-28322). The United States and Canadian Entities have reviewed this Agreement and are satisfied that there are mutual benefits to be derived from it and that these benefits can be achieved without adversely affecting: (1) the operation of Treaty storage in accordance with the Columbia River Treaty; and (2) the performance of obligations pursuant to the agreement entitled "Aspects of the Delivery of the Canadian Entitlement." The Columbia River Treaty Operating Committee is hereby instructed to ensure that any operation pursuant to this Agreement does not adversely affect the stream flow control in the Columbia River within Canada so as to reduce the flood control and hydroelectric power benefits which the operation of the Canadian Treaty storage in accordance with the operating plans in force from time to time would otherwise produce.
