

**COLUMBIA RIVER TREATY ENTITY AGREEMENT
ON THE
2011-12 STORAGE AGREEMENT (12NTSSA)**

The Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) and the British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority (B.C. Hydro) have signed an agreement relating to the use of Columbia River non-Treaty storage for the period 2 September 2011 through 25 November 2012 (BPA contract number 11PB-21385). The United States and Canadian Entities have reviewed this Agreement and are satisfied that there are mutual benefits to be derived from it and that these benefits can be achieved without adversely affecting: (1) the operation of Treaty storage in Canadian projects in accordance with the Columbia River Treaty; or (2) the performance of Treaty obligations pursuant to the agreement entitled "Aspects of Delivery of the Canadian Entitlement."

The Columbia River Treaty Operating Committee is hereby instructed to ensure that any operation pursuant to this Agreement does not adversely affect operation of Treaty storage pursuant to the Columbia River Treaty.

In witness thereof, the Entities have caused this agreement to be executed.
