

Extension of the Short-Term Bridge Agreement between Bonneville Power Administration and
British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority

Whereas Bonneville Power Administration and British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority (together referred to as "Parties") executed a short-term Non-Treaty Storage "Bridge" Agreement on 6 September 2011, BPA Contract No. 11PB-21385, that provided for mutually agreeable storage and release of water, and deliveries of energy from 2 September 2011 through 25 November, 2011; and

Whereas the Parties wish to extend the effective date of the Bridge Agreement; and

Whereas Section 2 of the Bridge Agreement permits changes to terms of the Agreement with mutual consent;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is understood and agreed between the Parties as follows:

Section 1 of the Bridge Agreement is amended as follows:

"Term

This Agreement will be effective at 2400 hours 2 September 2011, and will remain in effect until 2400 hours 30 March 2012; provided however that any outstanding obligations on 30 March 2012 with regard to any account established under this Agreement will be fulfilled in accordance with Section 7 of this Agreement."

Section 3 of the Bridge Agreement is amended as follows:

"Availability of Non-Treaty Accounts

BCH shall establish an account for each Party set at 1.85 km³ (1.5 million acre-feet (Maf)) with an initial balance in each Party's account of 1.85 km³ (1.5 Maf) of water."

Attachment 1 of the Bridge Agreement will be updated to reflect the increased volume of storage as amended in Section 3.
