Grand Coulee-Creston Transmission Line



BPA will rebuild nearly 28 miles of the Grand Coulee-Creston 115-kilovolt (kV) transmission line between the cities of Coulee Dam in Grant County and Creston in Lincoln County, Wash. The project will include replacing all structures and conductors. The rebuilt line will continue to operate at 115 kV.

Transmission line construction will begin in May 2015. All major construction activities will likely be completed by November 2015.

You are invited to join us for a “Meet the Builder” open-house meeting to learn about the construction schedule, speak with the construction contractor and meet the BPA project team. We do not plan to give a formal presentation, so you can come at any time.
