BPA Project Purpose

- Currently the Lyle Falls Fishway does not meet federal and state fish passage criteria for migrating adult salmon.
- Proposed project will modify the existing fish passage facility and construct a new fish-friendly facility designed to safely and effectively allow fish to move through the existing Lyle Falls in the Klickitat River.
- New facility is proposed to include:
 - video monitoring device
 - PIT tagging facility
 - improved attraction flows into the new fish passage facility
 - fish trapping facility that will enable monitoring and collection of brood stock for the Klickitat Fish Hatchery

 - Socioeconomics
 - Air quality
 - Noise
 - Public health and safety
