
Request:

I am requesting reports that are claimed to exist, authored by BPA, relating to the BPA 115KV line which runs generally east to west thru southern Skamania County Washington, and which eastern terminus is located at Bald Mountain substation in Klickitat County Washington. This is the line that serves the Skamania PUD, as well as other customers. The Klickitat PUD staff person, Ron Shultz, claimed he knew of the existance of such reports, but did not know the document numbers. He said the Skamania PUD Manager has copies of these BPA reports. Since these are BPA reports, I felt that Skamania PUD would be non-responsive in our request for BPA documents. Sorry I do not know the report numbers, that is why I originally contacted Bill Zimmerman at the Public Information Office. Bill forwarded this to the FOIA department to process.
