Thank you for your request for records that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA), under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. 552. Your request was received in this office on Friday, October 26, 2012, and has been assigned a control number, BPA-2013-00112-F. You have requested the following:

All documents related to the conveyance/transfer of land rights and 115kV transmission line (and related equipment/rights) in Okanogan and Douglas Counties, Washington from the United States/Bonneville Power Administration to Okanogan County Public Utility District No. 1 in March 1995. Records would include all materials related to the conveyance/transfer prior to and after the effective date of the conveyance/transfer, including any communications or correspondence between the United States or BPA with the Washington Department of Natural Resources.
