Thank you for your request for records that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. 552. Your request was received in this office on Tuesday, February 26, 2013, and assigned a control number, BPA-2013-00606-F. Please use this number in any correspondence with the Agency about your request.

You requested the following:

1. An accounting of all uncashed checks for at least six (6) months for \$1,000 or more. Include payee name, date, amount, and payee address.
2. An accounting of tax overpayments which have been refundable for at least six (6) months for \$1,000 or more. Include payee name, date, amount, and payee address.
3. An accounting of any unclaimed funds which have **not** been escheated to the state for \$1,000 or more. Include payee name, date, amount, and payee address.

We have reviewed your letter and have determined that it addresses all of the criteria of a proper request under the FOIA, DOE, and BPA regulation that implements the FOIA at Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 1004. You agreed to pay fees up to \$50.

Final response:

BPA has no responsive documents.

Pursuant to 10 CFR 1004.8, if you are dissatisfied with this determination, or the adequacy of the search, you may appeal in writing within 30 calendar days of receipt of a final response letter. The appeal should be made to the Director, Office of Hearings and Appeals, HG-1, Department of Energy, 1000 Independence Avenue, SW, Washington, DC 20585-1615. The written appeal, including the envelope, must clearly indicate that a FOIA Appeal is being made.

Fees totaling \$50 will be billed to you separately.
