Enclosed is a document entitled "RFO 2584 Abstract of Offers". Some information has been withheld under Exemption 3 of the FOIA.

Exemption 3 of FOIA requires the withholding of information that is prohibited from disclosure by another federal statute 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(3). 41 U.S.C. §4702 (b) prohibits an agency from disclosing a proposal that is in the possession or control of the agency, unless that proposal is set forth or incorporated by reference in a contract between the agency and the contractor.

The part of the document that is released is information that was required by law to be released to all bidders as the winning bid announcement.

Pursuant to 10 CFR 1004.8, if you are dissatisfied with this determination, or the adequacy of the search, you may appeal this FOIA response in writing within 30 calendar days of receipt of a final response letter. The appeal should be made to the Director, Office of Hearings and Appeals, HG-1, Department of Energy, 1000 Independence Avenue, SW, Washington, DC 20585-1615. The written appeal, including the envelope, must clearly indicate that a FOIA Appeal is being

made.
