This is the final response to your request for records that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA), under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. 552.

You requested the following:

1. PacifiCorp general transfer agreement with BPA for Klamath Falls, including any addenda or amendments to the agreement.
2. Documents relating the "wheeling cost" and provisions for adding points of delivery.

Response:

1. BPA has no responsive records as there is no general transfer agreement between BPA and PacifiCorp to serve Klamath Falls.
2. BPA has no responsive records related to "wheeling cost" and provisions for adding points of delivery under the agreement as there is no agreement.
