“All documents that document Bonneville's ongoing efforts 2010-2013 to capture, track, and analyze data to provide a quantitative assessment of Bonneville's compliance with the Age Discrimination in Employment Act of 1967; and with its adherence with Model EEO Program standards, especially as applicable to Bonneville's commitment to "Proactive prevention of unlawful discrimination"; along with the methodologies applied to sample design, the actual data collected, and the analytical techniques applied.”
