Thank you for your request for records that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA), under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. 552. Your request was received in this office on Wednesday, August 21, 2013, and has been assigned control number BPA-2013-01584-F. Please use this number in any correspondence with the Agency about your request.

You requested the following:

“Records related the discovery of cultural and historic resources along the Big Eddy/Knight Transmission Project in the vicinity of Celilo Falls and any communications regarding the eligibility of the Celilo Falls area for listing on the National Register of Historic Places. This request includes but not limited to all communications between the BPA and individuals, other government agencies, and tribal agencies.”

In an email dated September 11, 2013, you refined your request to “two documents; the determination of eligibility and effect, and the determination of eligibility that was provided to the keeper of the National Register.”
