This is a final release to your request for records that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. 552.

You requested:

- Copies of all emails, memos and presentations
- Dates of meetings, attendees, agenda and minutes
- Copies of telephone logs
- Copies of handwritten notes of attendees
- Date range for this request is January 2011 through date of this request.

Response:

BPA has no responsive telephone logs, meeting agendas or minutes.

BPA is releasing the documents gathered and released under BPA-2013-0036 I -F. Certain information is redacted pursuant to Exemption 6 of the FOIA.

BPA asserts this exemption for information which could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy if disclosed. The withheld information consists of the personal contact information (email and cell phone numbers) of individuals. There is no public interest in the disclosure of this information because it does not shed any light on how BPA has performed its statutory duties. Therefore, the individual privacy interest outweighs the public interest in the disclosure of this information.

Pursuant to 10 CFR 1004.8, if you are dissatisfied with this determination, or the adequacy of the search, you may appeal this FOIA response in writing within 30 calendar days of receipt of a final response letter. The appeal should be made to the Director, Office of Hearings and Appeals,

HG-1, Department of Energy, 1000 Independence Avenue, SW, Washington, DC 20585-1615.
The written appeal, including the envelope, must clearly indicate that a FOIA Appeal is being made.
