Dear Ms. Munro:

On page 23 of Department of Energy Inspector General's October, 2013 Special Inquiry Report (DOE/IG-0895), it is stated that "we also received informal comments from Bonneville that were submitted through the Department." The report goes on to briefly describe some of the points made in the Bonneville comments, but does not provide a complete copy.

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"), I hereby request the following:

1. A complete copy of the "informal comments" referred to on page 23 of DOE/IG-0895 that were supplied by BPA.
2. Any other comments that BPA supplied in response to the findings reported by the IG in DOE/IG-0895.

I make this request in my capacity as a member of the media, to wit, Senior Editor of Energy NewsData.

I am willing to discuss modifications to this request to ease BPA's burden in responding to it, or to accelerate the processing of the request.

Disclosure of this information is in the public interest because it is likely to contribute to public understanding of the operations or activities of the government and is not primarily in the commercial interest of myself, Energy NewsData or its publisher.

The subject of this request is the informal BPA response. Disclosure will enable the public to learn: the degree to which BPA agreed with the IG, the degree too which BPA did not agree with the IG; the basis for those agreements or disagreements, and their merits.

Therefore I request that any and all fees in connection with this request be waived.
