This is a partial response to your request for records that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA), under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. 552. Your requests were received in this office on Tuesday, December 24, 2013, with an acknowledgement letter sent to you on January 21, 2014.

You requested:

“The final, fully executed transmission agreement between the Bonneville Power Administration and Pacific Power for the delivery of power from Pacific Power to the North Hurlburt Wind, LLC, South Hurlburt Wind, LLC and Horseshoe Bend, LLC. Also, any drafts of this agreement, including any memorandum of understanding, term sheets or other contract development documents for the time period of January 1, 2007, to present.”

Response:

We conducted a search of the BPA Customer Account Executive records. We have located the latest executed transmission agreement with PacifiCorp, totaling three pages, that is responsive to your request. We are releasing these records in full. 


- (1) The nature of your appeal: denial of records, partial denial of records, adequacy of search, or denial of fee waiver;
