Mr. Wolf:

This is a final response to Mr. Healy's request for records that was made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA), under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. 552. The request was received in this office on Tuesday, December 24, 2013, with an acknowledgement letter sent to you on January 21, 2014.

Requested:

"All documents, including but not limited to, email, letters, or correspondence, between employees, representatives, or agents of the Bonneville Power Administration and employees, representatives, or agents of Pacific Power, Caithness, North Hurlburt Wind, LLC, South Hurlburt Wind LLC, or Horseshoe Bend Wind, LLC regarding the supply of electric power for station power service to the three wind projects. In this request, "Caithness" means Caithness Energy any of the affiliate companies of Caithness Energy, such as Caithness Development, LLC and Caithness Shepherds Flat, LLC."

Final Response:

The only documents found in response to this request were the interconnection agreements between BPA and Caithness for the North Hurlburt Wind, LLC, South Hurlburt Wind LLC, and Horseshoe Bend Wind, LLC, wind farms. BPA has no responsive emails or correspondence regarding the supply of "power service."

As the responsive documents for this request are duplicative of the FOIA request assigned tracking number BPA-2014-00387-F, we are closing this request. The responsive documents for tracking number BPA-2014-00387-F will be released following the appropriate Exemption 4 legal review.

Appeal:

Pursuant to Department of Energy FOIA regulations at 10 C.F.R. § 1004.8, you may administratively appeal this response in writing within 30 calendar days. If you choose to appeal, please include the following:

- (1) The nature of your appeal: denial of records, partial denial of records, adequacy of search, or denial of fee waiver;
- (2) Any legal authorities relied upon to support the appeal; and
- (3) A copy of the determination letter.
