Mr. Wolf:

This is a final response to Jerry Healy's requests for records that was made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA), under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. 552. His requests were received in this office on Tuesday, December 24, 2013. An acknowledgement letter was sent to Mr. Healy's attention, dated January 21, 2014, in which we provided an estimated delivery date of September 30, 2014.

During a September 22, 2014, phone conversation with Kim Winn you stated the Columbia Basin Electric Cooperative, Inc. (CBEC) wished to go forward with Mr. Healy's requests even though he is no longer employed at CBEC.

Requested:

All documents, including but not limited to, internal emails, correspondence, notes, minutes, and presentation documents, regarding communications among employees, representatives, or agents of the Bonneville Power Administration regarding the supply of power for station service loads of North Hurlburt Wind, LLC, South Hurlburt Wind, LLC, Horseshoe Bend Wind, LLC or the Saddle Butte project for the time period of January 1, 2007, to present.

Response:

The documents BPA found responsive for this request are duplicative of the documents found in response to your previous request, BPA-2014-00383-F. No additional documents were discovered. See the BPA-2014-00383-F response dated November 20, 2014, for those documents and an explanation of the redactions applied.

The inter-connection agreements that are responsive will be released upon the completion of the Exemption 4 analysis process. The current deadline for that release is estimated as June 30, 2015.

There are no fees associated with this request.

Appeal:
