Ms. Winn,

As you may recall, I spoke with over the phone last Friday, December 20, 2013. I asked if you had copies of contracts between BPA and EWEB concerning weatherization projects (energy efficiency projects) in effect for years 1983 -1986. You suggested I email you with the request and provide you a more detailed description of the documents I am requesting.

I understand that under the Northwest Power Act of 1980, BPA was to encourage energy efficiency among its customers. EWEB is one of BPA's customers. I understand from various sources that BPA provided some type of incentive to customers such as EWEB to promote energy efficient among their customers. I think these incentives to customer utilities may have been "billing credits" described in 16 USCA section 839d(h) and 839d(i). I understand EWEB followed BPA's lead and administrated a successful weatherization program for its customers, and received in return incentives from BPA.

The contracts I am requesting are the contracts in effect during 1983 -1986 between BPA and EWEB involving the BPA/EWEB weatherization programs and the BPA incentives.

I understand there was a BPA Weatherization Pilot Program that ran from 1980-1982. An interim Residential Weatherization Program that ran 1981-1983 and a Long-Term Weatherization Program that ran for 1983-1990.

I am requesting copies of contracts between BPA and EWEB for the period 1983-1986 under any of those three programs.
