Thank you for your request for records that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. 552. Your request was received in this office on Monday, January 27, 2014, and has been assigned control number BPA-2014-00537-F. Please use this number in any correspondence with BPA about your request.

#### **You requested the following:**

“All emails and attachments sent between Marchelle Watson and HCM (J. Makela, V. McClary, L. O’Leary, or others) between the periods of May 15, 2013-July 1 2014 regarding my status as a student intern conversion under Pathways or conversion under Schedule A hiring authority.”

In a phone conversation with Kim Winn on February 3, you clarified the date range of your request to be May 15, 2013, to July 1, 2013.

We have reviewed your request and have determined that it addresses all of the criteria of a proper request under the FOIA, DOE, and BPA regulation that implements the FOIA at Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 1004.

You agreed to pay all fees associated with this request. As a private citizen requesting information for your personal use, you are entitled to two hours of search time free of charge.

FOIA requires that we act on requests “promptly,” and that we make a determination on your request and respond within 20 working days. Additional time can be added if the requested records are voluminous, or if the records require review from an external organization or agency. (5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(6)). Based on the 20-day statutory timeline, the due date for a response to you is Tuesday, February 25, 2014.

Dear Mr. Edwards:

This letter is in reference to your Freedom of Information Act request dated January 27, 2014. BPA is not able to complete the request within the normal statutory timeframe.

**You requested:**

“All emails and attachments sent between Marchelle Watson and HCM (J. Makela, V. McClary, L. O’Leary, or others) between the periods of May 15 – July 1, 2013, regarding my status as a student intern conversion under Pathways or conversion under Schedule A hiring authority.”

FOIA requires that we act on requests “promptly,” and that we make a determination on your request and respond within 20 working days (5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(6)). The Bonneville Power Administration has instituted multi-track processing, as permitted by FOIA (5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(6)(D)(i)). Simple requests and complex requests are placed in two different queues, and each queue is processed on its own first-in, first-out basis. Requests are placed in the complex queue if they will require significant agency time or resources to process. Your request has been placed in the complex queue because it will require external review. We currently estimate that we can complete your request by June 30, 2014.
