This is the final response to your request for records that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. 552.

You requested:

Work papers, computer models, internal memos, and emails from Mr. Ridge's talking points in from the recent document entitled "Uranium Tails Transactions."

Response:

BPA has found no responsive documents. BPA was not involved in the Energy Northwest production of Mr. Ridge's talking points.
