Dear Mr. Pierard:

Thank you for your request for records that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA), under the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. 552. Your request was officially received in this office on Tuesday, February 25, 2014, and has been assigned a control number BPA-2014-00660-F. Please use this number in any correspondence with the Agency about your request.

#### **You requested:**

Copy of the BPA North Bonneville Substation Operator's Log Book entries concerning an apparent trip on the Bonneville Line No.2 to Midway Substation on March 10, 1945, at 1523 hours. PWT and any other effects of the trip such as Relay Targets Transfer Trip indication, etc. The Date Time & Line reference is from the Midway Operator's Log Book which stated that the 230KV BKR for the Bonneville Line No 2 tripped at 1523 and the Line went dead coming hot again 30 seconds later, and the Operator closed the BKR at 1524 No cause for the trouble noted (it was actually a fault on a 115KV Line, without a Line BKR out of Midway).

We have reviewed your letter and have determined that it addresses all of the criteria of a proper request under the FOIA, DOE, and BPA regulation that implements the FOIA at Title 10, code of Federal Regulations, Part 1004. Your request for a waiver of fees is granted.

#### **Final response:**

Both Transmission Services and the BPA Library have related that there are no responsive records.

The BPA Library has suggested that you contact the Seattle branch of the National Archives and Records Administration, as any BPA records of that age have been transferred there for storage.
