Thank you for your request for records that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA), under the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. 552. Your request was officially received in this office on Monday, March 17, 2014, and has been assigned a control number, BPA-2014-00720-F. Please use this number in any correspondence with the Agency about your request.

You requested:

“Provide copies of all documents from the Transmission Management Committee (TMC) meetings that reference or relate to: activities with PGE as a result of the recently signed MOU. The date range requested is from September 2013 through March 2014.”

In a phone conversation with Kim Winn, FOIA Public Liaison, on March 17, 2014, you clarified that the agreement you were requesting information on was the Cascade Crossing transmission project.
