Thank you for your request for records that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA), under the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. 552. Your request was officially received in this office on Friday, May 23, 2014, and has been assigned control number BPA-2014-01155-F. Please use this number in any correspondence with the Agency about your request.

You requested:

“Access to the HydroAMP website or it’s contents.”

In a phone conversation with Rose Anderson at McCullough Research, Kim Winn, FOIA Public Liaison, explained that the request for database access was not a proper request under the FOIA. Also, the request for the database content was too broad and did not reasonably describe the records that you were requesting. In an email dated Tuesday, June 3, 2014, the request was narrowed to: “documents describing the contents of the HydroAMP database and fields.”

We have reviewed your revised request and have determined that it addresses all of the criteria of a proper request under the FOIA, DOE, and BPA regulation that implements the FOIA at Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 1004. Your request for a waiver of fees is granted.

Response:

BPA has no records that describe the contents of the HydroAMP database. BPA is releasing the requested database fields in their entirety.

This is a final response. Pursuant to 10 CFR 1004.8, if you are dissatisfied with this determination, or the adequacy of the search, you may appeal in writing within 30 calendar days of receipt of a final response letter. The appeal should be made to:
