Hi Kim,

The purpose of my writing you is to ask for a fee waiver in reference to my FOIA request.

- 1) My request directly involves the operations and activities of the government
- 2) The informative value of information learned is "likely to contribute" to an understanding of government operations and activities
- 3) The contribution to the understanding by the general public is likely to be considerable if the information leads to actions that will protect public health, safety, ground water, rivers, the aquifer and air quality. This information will be helpful to inform the public of any threats to public health and safety
- 4) The significance of the information may contribute "significantly" to the public understanding of how government activities may be directly related to how public health and safety issues arise and are sometimes left unattended and how government interacts with other companies before and after issues arise
- 5) My commercial interest in this matter is none whatsoever. The sole reason I am making the request is to protect public health and safety.
- 6) There is not commercial value to me in my request
- 7) If my fee waiver is denied, I am willing to pay \$50 for information that may help in my endeavor to protect public health and safety.

Kim, it may be helpful to narrow my search to reduce the amount of time needed to research and obtain information.

I would like to narrow the search to apply to only these specific areas:

- Terrebonne, Oregon
- Redmond, Oregon
- Bend, Oregon
