This is a final response to your request for Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) records under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. § 552. Your request was received in this office on August 26, 2014 with an acknowledgment letter sent to you on September 9, 2014. On September 5, 2014, you revised your request via email.

You requested:

The yearly costs of the RAMS Security contract from 2009-2014.

Response:

We conducted a search of the electronic records of the Contracting Office and they provided the following information:

Fees:

Fees totaling \$77.24 are associated with this request. However, you agreed to pay \$65.00 of these fees for which you will be billed separately.

Appeal:

You may still seek administrative appeal pursuant to Department of Energy FOIA regulations at 10 C.F.R. § 1004.8 if you feel the search was not adequate. If you choose to appeal, you must do so in writing within 30 days, and include the following information:

- (1) The nature of your appeal - denial of records, partial denial of records, adequacy of search, or denial of fee waiver;
- (2) Any legal authorities relied upon to support the appeal; and
- (3) A copy of this determination letter.

Clearly mark both your letter and envelope with the words "FOIA Appeal," and direct it to the following address:
