We have received your request for records under the Freedom of Information Act (5 U.S.C. § 552). Thank you for your interest in the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA). Your letter was received in this office on September 8, 2014, and has been assigned control number BPA-2014-01847-F. Please use this number in any correspondence with the agency about your request.

You requested:

"CHaMP Survey Geodatabases for the Methow River Basin, WA from 2011-2013 (and 2014 once it becomes available this fall). I am particularly interested in the Digital Elevation Models of the topographic surveys."

When responding to FOIA requests, BPA can only process records in existence. A FOIA request cannot be made for future records (2014 survey). Therefore, there are no records responsive to your request as it pertains to the 2014 CHaMP Survey Geodatabase for the Methow River Basin, WA.


