Mr. Johnson:

This is a final response to your request for Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) records under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. § 552. Your request was received in our office on November 3, 2014, with an acknowledgement letter sent to you on November 6, 2014.

You requested:

“Detailed workpapers for the 2013 and 2014 nuclear fuel numbers on page 31 of Energy Northwest's 2014 Annual Report.”

Response:

We conducted searches of BPA records in the offices of Contract Generating Resources, Federal Hydro Projects, and the Office of General Counsel. The results of those efforts determined that BPA possesses no records responsive to your request.

Your request for a fee waiver was granted. There are no fees associated with this request.

Appeal:

You may seek administrative appeal pursuant to Department of Energy FOIA regulations at 10 C.F.R. § 1004.8. If you choose to appeal, you must do so in writing within 30 days, and include the following information:

- (1) The nature of your appeal - denial of records, partial denial of records, lack of responsive records, or denial of fee waiver;
- (2) Any legal authorities relied upon to support the appeal; and
- (3) A copy of this determination letter.

Clearly mark both your letter and envelope with the words "FOIA Appeal," and direct it to the following address:
