RE: FOIA Request

Dear Mr. Frost:

I am a retired attorney making the following requests on behalf of CENSE (Coalition of Eastside Neighborhoods for Sensible Energy), an independent non-profit organization, funded by concerned residents and run by volunteers. Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552, I request all documents, electronic or otherwise, draft and final, including e-mail correspondence, presentations, correspondence, draft agreements, and notes, related to the following:

The design, purpose, need, scope, studies and objections to or concerns about the project presently referred to as Energize Eastside ("Project") as proposed by Puget Sound Energy. These requests also extend to a project that was/is an immediate precursor to the Project, proposed by PSE to the ColumbiaGrid consortium and referred to by PSE as "Sammamish-Lakeside-Talbot Hill" as a regional grid reinforcement project which involved/involves the Energize Eastside subsequently designated segments "C-E-J-M" and proposing the same kind of upgrade in the existing 115kV lines to 230kV with an upgraded or new transformer at Lakeside. Documents requested include, but are not limited to, those documents relating to any proposed or actual cost sharing by or between utilities associated with or otherwise contacted concerning the Project and/or "Sammamish-Lakeside-Talbot Hill", including by and between Seattle City Light, PSE and BPA, including draft and final agreements, e-mail correspondence, and invoices. Documents requested also include those related to the Project and/or "Sammamish-Lakeside-Talbot Hill" which were transmitted between or among Seattle City Light and any other agencies, energy and other companies, and/or non-profit consortia, including, but not limited to, BPA, Puget Sound Energy, other Seattle City departments, ColumbiaGrid, FERC, and the Western Electricity Coordinating Council. Further, all documents, electronic or otherwise, draft and final, including e-mail correspondence, are requested concerning any and all communications between Puget Sound Energy and Seattle City Light with respect to any use or sharing of Seattle City Light's rights of way and/or easements and/or power lines which are located on the Eastside.

Please include in your search and production of these documents any and all load and/or reliability forecasts for the future electricity needs of the Eastside or any portion of it in your possession, regardless of by whom made or for what purpose.

Please consider the relevant time period for these requests to be from 2008 to the present.

Please produce responsive documents in native electronic format (as generated by the computer program that created them, as opposed to files converted to graphics format (e.g. TIFF, JPG, PNG, GIF formats) or in PDF format (unless that is the only way an electronic document has survived). As the owner of a computer forensics company I am technically versed in the identification, culling, extraction and delivery of electronic documents, and I will gladly assist you in that regard if you wish.

Finally, as noted above, CENSE is a volunteer-driven non-profit organization of citizens who want to make sure the cities whose approvals are sought to permit the Project, as well as the citizenry they serve, are adequately informed of the supposed need for and extent of the proposed Project. Accordingly, we ask you to waive any fees you would otherwise charge for fulfilling these requests.
