This is a final response to your request for Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) records under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. § 552. Your request was received in our office on February 23, 2015 with an acknowledgement letter sent to you on March 5, 2015.

You requested:

"I request a copy of any and all communications and documents, including but not limited to emails, written communications, notes, text messages, memos as well as any other form of written or electronic communication, containing any reference to or regarding Brim Aviation, Brim Equipment Leasing or Burl Brim."

Response:

On March 10, 2015, you withdrew your request letter, which we received in our office on March 12, 2015. This letter confirms that your request is considered withdrawn and has been administratively closed. No further action will be taken by this office.

Fees

Due to the length of time we worked on your request you incurred search fees of \$28.96. You will not be billed the aforementioned amount since you will not receive the documents you had requested. However, should you make another FOIA request, the fee listed above would need to be paid in advance prior to moving forward with future requests.

Because your request was withdrawn and no determination was made on the records, you do not have appeal rights under Department of Energy FOIA regulations at 10 C.F.R. § 1004.8. You may refile your request at any time.
