This is a final response to your request for Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) records under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. § 552. Your request was received in our office on April 10, 2015, with an acknowledgement letter sent to you on April 13, 2015.

You requested:

“The proposals that were provided to BPA for the last IT Supplemental Labor RFP and Engineering Supplemental Labor RFP.”

In an email dated April 13, 2015, to Kim Winn, you limited your request to “the winning proposal for the most recent IT Supplemental Labor RFP.”

Response:

After conducting a thorough search of paper and electronic records in Contracting, we have determined that there are no records responsive to your request.

In accordance with the Bonneville Purchasing Instructions (BPI) (see the following website for more information: <http://www.bpa.gov/doing%20business/purchase/pages/default.aspx>), BPA did not to issue a formal RFO specifically for IT supplemental labor. Based on market research, past performance and internal needs, 18 Master Agreements were issued to existing supplemental labor vendors. Positions are competed amongst these vendors utilizing the Supplemental Labor Information Management (SLIM) system.

This notification letter is our final action on this request.

There are no fees associated with this request.

Appeal:

You may seek administrative appeal pursuant to Department of Energy FOIA regulations at 10 C.F.R. § 1004.8. If you choose to appeal, you must do so in writing within 30 days, and include the following information:

- (2) Any legal authorities relied upon to support the appeal; and
- (3) A copy of this determination letter.
