### **You requested:**

“Please provide the first and last name, business phone number, and business email address from any lawyers that have represented BPA employees or contractors since January 1, 2012 with regard to Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) at Bonneville. By “matters,” I mean any type of complaint, including any stage in the process, whether the lawyer was retained by the employee for a portion of the process or the entire process. I am not requesting any employee names or personal information of employees, nor am I requesting any information regarding the complaints identified with such lawyers.

I would prefer to receive a partial list with requested information as opposed to a complete list, if the complete list going back to January 1, 2012 would delay receiving any information (partial list) by more than 7 days.”

On May 18, 2015, Kim Winn contacted you via email, requesting clarification of the FOIA request. It was agreed upon that only the lawyer contact information will be provided for the present to 2012.

BPA has twenty (20) working days to respond to your request. The due date for a response to you is Tuesday, June 16, 2015.
