Mr. Carbonari:

This is a final response to your request for Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) records under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. § 552. Your request was received in our office on May 11, 2015, with an acknowledgement letter sent to you on May 26, 2015.

You requested:

“[T] the first and last name, business phone number, and business email address from any lawyers that have represented BPA employees or contractors since January 1, 2012 with regard to Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) at Bonneville.”

On May 18, 2015, Kim Winn contacted you via email, requesting clarification of the FOIA request. You agreed at that time that the lawyer contact information would be provided for the present going back to 2012.

Response:

We conducted a search of the electronic records of Office of General Counsel. We have located 2 pages of material responsive to your request. We are releasing these records in full. Our original search did not include phone numbers and e-mail addresses. Rather than delaying the response by doing the search over again, the FOIA Office found the phone numbers and email addresses online and added it to the search results.

Appeal:

You may still seek administrative appeal pursuant to Department of Energy FOIA regulations at 10 C.F.R. § 1004.8 if you feel the search was not adequate. If you choose to appeal, you must do so in writing within 30 days, and include the following information:

- (1) The nature of your appeal - denial of records, partial denial of records, adequacy of search, or denial of fee waiver;
- (2) Any legal authorities relied upon to support the appeal; and
- (3) A copy of this determination letter.

Clearly mark both your letter and envelope with the words "FOIA Appeal," and direct it to the following address:
