The information actually provided in response may have included the actual the Limited Pay ability Cancellation Report(s), a list of deposits into Treasury Account 20x6133, or a list of check( s )/warrant( s).

Please include:

An electronic copy of correspondence(s) between your entity and the requestor.

An electronic copy of the actual records provided in response to the request which related to unclaimed, uncashed, or undelivered check(s)/warrant(s). For example, the list of checks provided in response to the request.

NOTE: I am not interested in receiving records where the request did not result in records actually being provided to the requestor.

2. In the alternative, if the above records do not exist or cannot be found, please provide the most current information related to unclaimed, uncashed, or undelivered check(s)/warrant(s) such as Limited Pay ability Cancellation Report(s), or a list of deposits into Treasury Account 20x6133.”

As your request was addressed to numerous entities within the Department of Energy (DOE), BPA has consulted with the DOE FOIA Office and we were advised that that the DOE FOIA office will officially respond for the agency.
