Mr. Campbell:

We have received your request for records under the Freedom of Information Act (5 U.S.C. § 552). Thank you for your interest in the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA). Your request was received in this office on Friday, July 10, 2015, and has been assigned control number BPA-2015-01591-F. Please use this number in any correspondence with the agency about your request.

You requested:

“A copy of the solicitation and all amendments issued by the Bonneville Power Authority [*sic*] or its designated contracting agency for the work performed by Power Engineers to prepare Appendix D, Underground Route Study, of the I-5 Corridor Reinforcement - Draft Environment Impact Statement (EIS). The solicitation or its equivalent should include the “performance work statement” (PWS) or “statement of work” (SOW) that describes the background, objectives, scope of work, specific tasks, and deliverables for services performed under the solicitation.

This request does not seek any pricing or proprietary data of Power Engineers. The request is limited to information prepared by the government for the purpose of soliciting services that led to the preparation of Appendix D of the I-5 Corridor Reinforcement Draft EIS.”

We have reviewed your request and have determined that it addresses all of the criteria of a proper request under the FOIA, DOE, and BPA regulation that implements the FOIA at Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 1004.

You requested a waiver of fees. Your request is denied. As an “individual” requester you are entitled to two free hours of search time. Above and upon those two hours, you have agreed to pay \$25 in fees.

BPA has twenty (20) working days to respond to your request. The original due date for a response to you is Friday, August 7, 2015; however, BPA will be taking the allowed ten working-day extension. The new target date for a response to you is Friday, August 21, 2015.
