Mr. Preston:

This is a final response to your request for Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) records under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. § 552. Your request was received in our office on Monday, July 20, 2015.

You requested:

“The names and contact information for all applicants for the following position: Physical Security Specialist, DOE BPA-15-10913-DE and DOE BPA 15-10913-MP.”

Response:

In a phone conversation with Kim Winn, Case Coordinator, dated July 20, 2015, Ms. Winn explained Exemption 6 privacy protection under the FOIA (5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6)). She explained that the names and contact information of applicants who were not hired is information that falls under Exemption 6 and cannot be discretionarily released; the right of privacy belongs to the individual, not to the agency.

In that phone conversation you withdrew your request. This letter confirms that your request is considered withdrawn and has been administratively closed. No further action will be taken by this office.

Because your request was withdrawn and no determination was made on records, you do not have appeal rights under Department of Energy FOIA regulations at 10 C.F.R. § 1004.8. You may refile your request at any time.
