We have received your request for records under the Freedom of Information Act (5 U.S.C. § 552). Thank you for your interest in the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA). Your request was received in this office on July 20, 2015, and has been assigned control number BPA-2015-01645-F. Please use this number in any correspondence with the agency about your request.

### **You requested:**

“Does BPA still use Inven products for power digital protection and fiber optic monitoring?”

As related to you in a phone conversation with Kim Winn on July 20, 2015, the FOIA does not answer questions, but government documents. In an email dated July 20, 2015, you revised your request to:

“Any purchase orders from BPA to INIVEN LLC or Zzyxx LLC for PDR-2000 or FIDRA from May 1, 2015, through present.”

You also stated that you did not want the quantity purchased or pricing information.

We have reviewed your letter and determined that it addresses all of the criteria of a proper request under the FOIA and the Department of Energy’s FOIA regulations at Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 1004.

You have agreed to pay all fees.
