Mr. Horn:

This is a final response to your request for Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) records under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. § 552. Your request was received in our office on July 20, 2015, with an acknowledgement letter sent to you on July 23, 2015.

### **You requested:**

“Any purchase orders from BP A to INIVEN LLC or Zzyxx LLC for PDR-2000 or FIDRA from May 1, 2015, through present.”

You also stated that you did not want the quantity purchased or pricing information.

### **Response:**

After conducting a thorough search of the electronic records in Engineered Materials' Bonneville Enterprise System, we have determined that there are no records responsive to your request. This notification letter is our final action on this request.

You agreed to pay all applicable fees. Fees totaling \$147.57 are associated with this request (3 hours at \$49.19/hour). You will be billed separately for that amount.

### **Appeal:**

You may seek administrative appeal pursuant to Department of Energy FOIA regulations at 10 C.F.R. § 1004.8. If you choose to appeal, you must do so in writing within 30 days, and include the following information:

- (1) The nature of your appeal - denial of records, partial denial of records, lack of responsive records, or denial of fee waiver;
- (2) Any legal authorities relied upon to support the appeal; and

(3) A copy of this determination letter.

Clearly mark both your letter and envelope with the words "FOIA Appeal," and direct it to the following address:
