Description of Document(s) Requested*:

The raw data for hydrographic soundings taken in the navigation channel at Ice Harbor Channel and Dam, Schultz Bar and at the confluence of the Clearwater and Snake Rivers at Lewiston. If there are other areas between the Mouth of the Snake and Lewiston that you have taken sounding I would appreciate those as well.

Could you provide the soundings as an ASCII file in an XYZ format along with the vertical and horizontal datum used in collecting the data.

I would like to request line drawings of the Navigation Locks and approach guide walls for McNary, Ice Harbor, Lower Monumental, Little Goose and Lower Granite Dams. I would like this information Geo-Referenced and if possible in a DXF format. I can work with other formats if DXF is not possible.

Any information on Bridge or Power Line heights you may have for the Columbia River in the Tri-Cities area and the Snake River between the Mouth and Lewiston. One bridge of notable interest is the Tucannon Railroad Bridge (Sargent Bridge) at Snake River mile 61.7.

Please contact me for any needed clarifications.
