You requested:

Copies of presentations made to the Administrator and/or his staff from July 1, 2015, to the date of this request that discussed the specific issues, reasons and concerns that has led to the decision to delay the I-5 Corridor Reinforcement Project Final Environmental Impact Statement from sometime late in 2015, to before the end of 2015, and now to sometime in 2016.
